A rise in the number of cases of mental retardation, tension, anxiety and hypertension are some c the major effects of noise pollution. Noise pollution is created by pressure horns, unturned engines, damage silencers, over speeding and excessive use of the first two gears. Medically, acceptable noise level is betwee 60 to 70 decibels (dB). In Pakistan the national environment quality standard for noise is 85 dB, whereas bus road the average noise pollution is 96 dB. There are innumerable sources of noise but they can be broadl classified into two categories. The noise from industrial sources is the most hazardous and affects worker' health as well efficiency.
