Summary :-

Gender inequality is highly practiced in educational sector due to cultural boundaries. People do not educate their girls as to them the girls have no responsibility other than housemaking. According to ministry of women development (2007) only 5% BA degrees & 1.4% masters degree have been acquired and according to 2020 world forum economics half the women are literate compared to 71% men. Various stereotypes lead to joblessness, prohibition from owning land, control over economic resources and this leads to their economic backwardness. 85% men work in labour force while only one-quarter women are working. According to WEF 2020 only 5% of senior leadership is in hands of women and only 18% of income goes to them. For economic growth and sustainability, Pakistan must improve the economic status of women.

Q. No. 2 Part (ii) WOMEN EDUCATION:- There is a huge discrimination in the education sector among boys and girls. Families usually think it unnecessary to impart education to their daughters simply due to cultural boundaries. According to them girls are supposed to get married eventually and take on their major responsibilities of housemaking and babysitting. Therefore the percentage of girls studying/taking education is less than that of boys.

Q. No. 2 Part (iii) **Rural Drop outs**:- majority of the rural girls drop out just after attending primary school, some even dropout during it. The sole reason is because of the backwardness of mindset in the rural areas where families usually think that it is unnecessary to impart education to girls because they are eventually going to end up getting married and none of their education is going to benefit them in any way. Moreover another reason could be the culture of early marriages in the rural areas.

Factors leading to Joblessness:-

There are a number of factors leading to joblessness of women. This may be due to poor or irrelevant academics of women, marriage as well as cultural stereotypes that lead to economic backwardness of women. Moreover, due to their "gender" they are not given job opportunities even if they are educated. This leads to them being dependent on men and some even live below poverty line as they are barred from owning land and having control over economic resources.

Labour contributions of women:-

According to a report, only one quarter of women participate in the labour force as compared to 85% of men. Moreover, the WEF 2020 report says that only 6.5% of leadership roles and 18% of income is attributed to women. So, the labour contribution is very low and this is generally because the women are prohibited from owning land, they are given less work opportunities than men simply due to their gender. They face joblessness due to various cultural boundaries and stereotypes.

However from this half, only 10% is contributing to economic growth.
