NOTIFICATION

It is notified for information and necessary action of all concerned that after the implementation of National Curriculum of Pakistan (NCP) 2022-23 in the subjects of English (Compulsory), Urdu (Compulsory), Islamiyat Compulsory, Pakistan Studies, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science and Mathematics at SSC-I/HSSC-I level with effect from academic session 2024-25 and SSC-II/HSSC-II level with effect from academic session 2025-26, the following decisions have been taken for ensuring smooth transition:

- i. The students of SSC-I and HSSC-I who appeared in Old Course (Curriculum 2006) in 2024 examinations and who want to re-appear (for improvement/passing the failed papers) are allowed to appear in the same Old Course (Curriculum 2006) up to 2nd Annual Examination 2027.
- ii. The students of SSC-II and HSSC-II who will appear in Curriculum 2006 in Annual Examinations 2025 will also be allowed to re-appear (for improvement/passing the failed papers) in their respective Old Course (Curriculum 2006) up to 2nd Annual Examination 2027.
- iii. In the subject of Mathematics HSSC-II, the students who have already appeared either in Curriculum 2000 or 2006 will also be allowed to re-appear (for improvement/passing the failed papers) in their respective Old Curricula/Courses up to 2nd Annual Examination 2027.
- iv. Curriculum 2022-23 of Islamiyat Compulsory successfully stands implemented at SSC level while for Islamiyat Compulsory at HSSC-I level, the students who appeared in Old Course will also be allowed to re-appear (for improvement or passing the failed papers) in their Old Course up to 2nd Annual Examination 2027.
- v. In other such cases of major shift/change in Curricula/Courses, up to four (04) chances would be provided to the candidates to re-appear (for improvement/passing the failed papers) in their respective Old Curricula/Courses.
- vi. Students will clearly indicate their appearance in Old Course/Curriculum at the time of sending admission to the Board.
